The Youth Organization of the European Naturist Federations (EuNat federations in the INF-FNI) Internal Regulations (proposal 2018)

§ 1: Name and members

- a) The European Naturist Youth (ENY) is the youth organization of the European Naturist Federations (EuNat) within the International Naturist Federation (INF-FNI).
- b) The ENY members (*European countries with organized youth groups and EU-federation members without official youth groups*) are young naturists between 14 (*) and 27 years.
(*) *A lower age limit is possible for a specific Youth group upon request to the ENY committee.*

§ 2: General characterization and fundamentals

The ENY, as part of the INF-FNI and EuNat, must comply with:

- a) Actual ENY internal regulations.
- b) EuNatCom (ENC) internal and financial-sport regulations.
- c) INF-FNI statutes and their internal regulations.

§ 3: Main Aims

- a) To represent the interests of the European ENY members.
- b) To promote and support the implementation of new Naturist Youth groups.
- c) To represent the interests of young naturists on the European level.

§ 4: Main activities

- a) Supporting the member organizations.
- b) Organizing the springtime meeting.
- c) Organizing the Summer Meeting(s).
- d) Exchanging ideas on national naturist and sports developments in the field of youth with the delegates through E-mail and social networks.

§ 5: ENY Finances

- a) The main financial resources are described in the annual budget allocated by EuNat.
- b) Other resources of the ENY are derived from all forms of assistance accepted by the ENY Committee.

§ 6: The youth officer can appoint persons of all groups for projects.

§ 7: Miscellaneous
