### **FENAIT discussion point for the EuNat 2019 meeting in Luxembourg.**

The Italian naturist association UNI (Unione Naturisti Italiani) officially leaves FENAIT, and consequently INF/FNI, on 5<sup>th</sup> January 2019, due to disagreement with the new Fenait governance and for difficulties in accepting the rules all other Italian naturist associations must follow; during 2018 they refused to pay the annual fee, while illegally retaining a significant number of stamps. As a result of this behaviour, in 2018 they accumulated debts for about € 10,000.

Before leaving, probably during the month of December, they requested and obtained several hundreds of INF stamps and cards from the LNV.

LNV accepted the request, shipping all the stamps at the same time. After UNI leaves Fenait, they started to sell these stamps to their members in Italy. I was at the UNI GA (general assembly) held on 5<sup>th</sup> January and I can say for sure.

When Fenait firstly became aware of this situation, (in December, before UNI leaves and then after 5<sup>th</sup> January), informally, asked for clarifications to INF president and treasurer. They replied that individual member should join a foreign federation. Such an answer is not acceptable because no member has directly requested LNV to join; probably the majority of them do not even know what LNV is!

All the stamps was shipped at once for selling in Italy contravening the INF rules.

Some further objective facts:

- before these events, LNV had less than 10 members, no location but only a P.O. box in Switzerland, no website, only a Swiss e-mail address; now has sold several hundreds stamps in a foreign country where an INF federation operates;
- President of LNV is the INF/FNI treasurer;
- Gianfranco Ribolzi, UNI vice president, during the last UNI G.A., publicly stated he paid each stamp less than € 4,00 (the prize Fenait sells the stamps to its federated association). If that

is true, then LNV should have known they are not selling the stamps to individual members; the price for individuals is much higher!

- LNV delegate in the last WC and EUNAT was Rosita Dal Soglio, now member of INF CC;
- Rosita Dal Soglio for many years was member of UNI and Fenait CC;
- Rosita Dal Soglio in the last years, managed Le Betulle Campsite in Torino (where the UNI is established), property of president and vice president of UNI ;
- Rosita Dal Soglio, at the moments, lives, with her family, at the Le Betulle Campsite;
- Rosita Dal Soglio, although she is not member of UNI nor other Italian naturist association, was present on 5<sup>th</sup> January 2019 at the UNI GA, where some illegal stamps was sold to Italian UNI members;
- UNI, at the moment, is not affiliated with any naturist federation, nor Fenait, nor LNV; it is established in Italy, and is illegally selling LNV stamps to unsuspecting members.

With this motion, Fenait asks:

- EUNAT recognizes LNV is selling stamps not to individuals members but to a foreign association that is not a member, and not affiliated to INF/FNI;
- EUNAT reiterates the rules to all federations that provide they should sell stamps abroad to individual members only. Every member must have direct and individual associative relationship with the supplier of the stamps;
- That the LNV compensates FENAIT for the damage caused by its conduct, for an amount of € 4,00 for every stamps sold to UNI.

Financial impact: no cost for EUNAT.
